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Wrist Pin Cushion

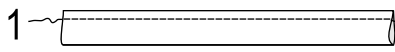


Materials

10" x 8" piece of cloth

2" x 3" piece of chipboard

6" of 3/4" elastic

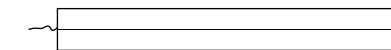


1 We start with the wrist band. Fold wrist band piece right sides together. Stitch open side along length.

2 Turn right-side out and iron flat with the seam in the center.

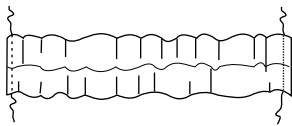


3 Using a safety pin, pull the elastic through the band matching the loose end with the opening of the band. Stitch elastic in place. Pull the pin end through to the other open end of the band (forcing the band to gather). Stitch elastic in place.

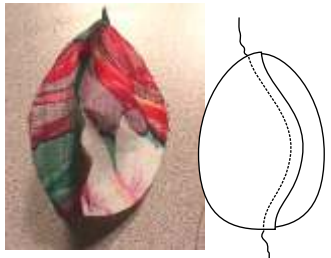


4 Take body pieces and sew along top between **A** and **B**.



5 Stitch both ends of wrist band to the body piece (on right side of fabric) at the sides with open ends of the band facing out and the non-seam side of the band should face down.

6 Lay the bottom piece over the body piece (Right sides together), matching A's and B's. The band should be between the two pieces. You will need to hold it to one side and let it stick out. Sew from point A of the body piece around the bottom to just past point B.

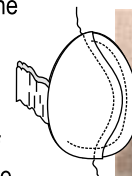
Turn right sides out.

7 Insert chipboard and sew opening half-way. Through remainder opening, stuff on top of the chip board and fill the cushion firmly.

8 Once filled, stitch the opening closed. Add pins and you're ready to go.

Follow Steps 1-3

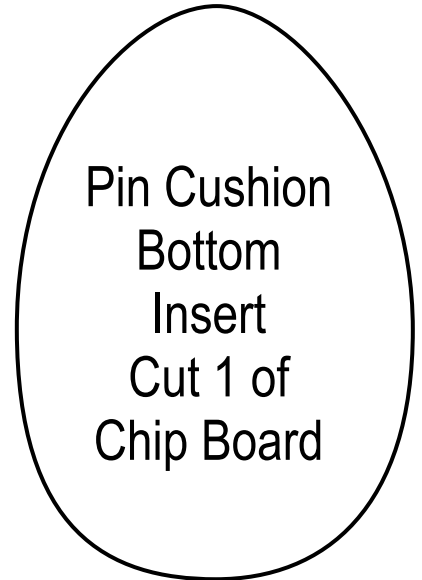
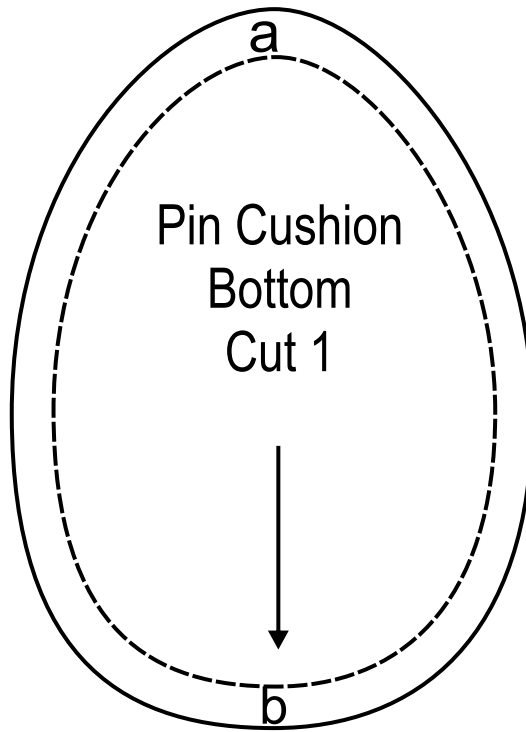
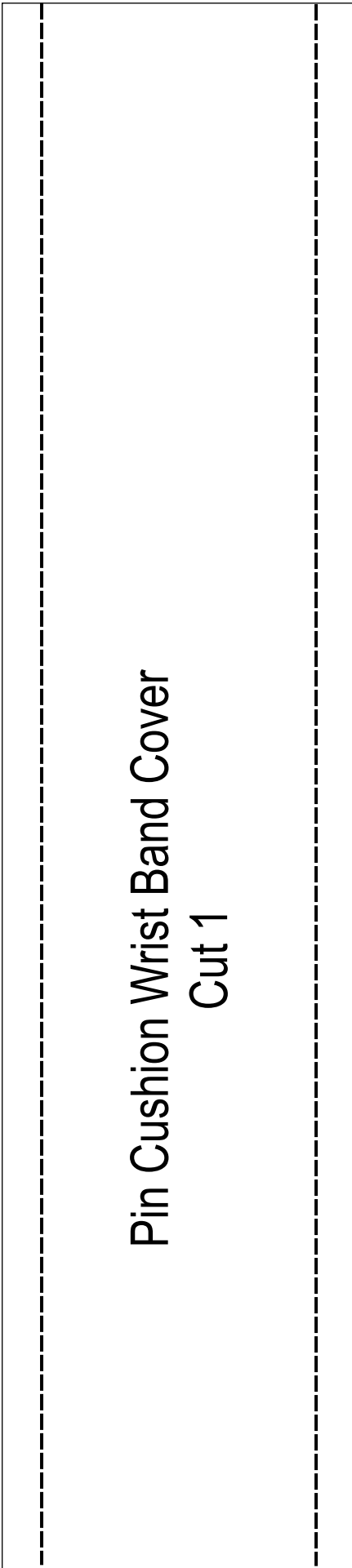
4a Take body pieces and sew along top between **C** and **B**.
